Aim	<p>Education Supervision Orders are a rarely used and often misunderstood tool which, if used properly, can be far more productive in ensuring children engage successfully with the education they are legally entitled to.</p> <p>Designed with you in mind, this course covers all you'll need to know in order to correctly consider, apply and supervise Education Supervision Orders.
