Aim	<p>This course is designed for those involved in setting up <i>Public Spaces Protection Orders</i> and issuing <i>Fixed Penalty Notices</i> to persons who are in breach of these orders. It covers the legislative background to the notices, revises the rules for street interviews in accordance with code C of the codes of practice issued under PACE, and discusses the evidence that is needed to back up the notice.</p> <p>It also covers the steps required to enforce notices and the paperwork you can use, and offers options that are available if a notice is not deemed to be suitable.</p> <p>By the time they've finished, your delegates will have practised issuing notices in a variety of scenarios and will feel confident in their abilities.</p>
