<b>Overview</b>	<p>Working within public body investigation in Jersey means that, if you want to carry out surveillance or use a <i>covert human intelligence source</i> (CHIS), you've got to get to grips with the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Jersey) Law 2005 (RIPL).</p> <p>In today's surveillance climate, where investigators are increasingly in the public eye, you'll want to make sure that you and your organisation are doing it right. Whether you're an applicant, a supervisor / gatekeeper or authorising officer, you need to know the rules!</p> <p>Don't get caught out : make sure that you know how to apply for directed surveillance, that you understand proportionality and necessity properly, and that you know about all of the RIPL procedures and how to properly oversee the application process.</p>
