Aim	<p>Safety in the workplace is everyone's concern and it's important for those working on land-based sites to be confident that all their colleagues (that's employees and contractors) know their responsibilities. That's why the industry runs a smartcard scheme – the LISS/CSCS SmartCard.</p> <p>This course covers everything you need to know about site safety – covering personal risks, keeping your colleagues safe and looking after the environment. As an employer, sending someone on the course shows that you are properly training your staff. In terms of site access, on completion of the ROLO assessment, you and your staff will be able to obtain the LISS/CSCS SmartCard administered by the British Association of Landscape Industries at the 'Operatives' or 'AQP' level.</p> <p>This training can be delivered face-to-face or online. Online delivery can be either one full day or two half-days and we run online courses which avoid school pickup times at weekends. (As a bonus, our ROLO trainers are both ex-HSE inspectors, bringing a wealth of relevant experience to the training – which helps make a dry subject interesting!)</p>			
Course requirements	Delegates must provide proof of identity (such as passport, ID card or driving license). For online training, delegates must have a PC / Laptop / Tablet with camera and microphone enabled.
